Dear Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the European Convention on Extradition 1957 and to its Second, Third and Fourth Protocols, which the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland ratified on 13 February 1991, 8 March 1994, 23 September 2014 and 23 September 2014, respectively (together “the Convention”).

I have further the honour to inform you that the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland wishes the application of the Convention to be extended to the territory of Gibraltar, for whose international relations the United Kingdom is responsible.

The Government of the United Kingdom requests the Secretariat General of the Council of Europe to circulate this Note to all other Contracting Parties informing them that, pursuant to Article 27, paragraph 4, of the Convention, an arrangement giving effect to this extension will be deemed to have been made between the United Kingdom and each of the Contracting Parties from which the Secretariat has not received a Note of objection within 90 days of the date of circulation.
